**Cognitive Advantages of Bilingual Children in Different ...**

Bilingual children outperformed monolinguals on selective attention The cognitive effect of bilingualism was most clearly present in the Frisian-Dutch group and in a subgroup of migrant children who were relatively proficient in Polish The effect was less robust in the Limburgish-Dutch sample
